Best of all, the makeup (which includes foundation, finishing powder, blush, bronzer, eye shadow, and lip gloss) looks great: The finishing powder blends easily into the skin, the eye shadow imparts a subtle sexy shimmer, and the lip gloss has a wonderful "barely there" tint. —Megan O'Neill

Soothing hand sanitizers

WHEN YOU NEED TO WASH YOUR HANDS but can't get to a sink, hand sanitizers are the answer. A new crop of all-natural sanitizers is loaded with skin-soothing essential oils. Our picks contain at least 60 percent alcohol—the amount recommended by the Centers for Disease Control to banish bacteria. Use only when soap and water aren't available—and only half a teaspoon to avoid irritating your skin, says Rebecca Tung, M.D., a dermatologist at the Cleveland Clinic in Cleveland, Ohio.

FRAIS HAND SANITIZER is made with 66 percent sugarcane alcohol, which requires less energy to produce than the corn alcohol used in most sanitizers, and a blend of eight essential oils including ginger and tangerine that keep skin hydrated. It's also available in a 0.2 ounce size that's perfect for tucking into pockets and purses.

EO ORGANIC HAND SANITIZING sprays, gels, and wipes contain 62 percent organic, non-genetically modified corn alcohol and organically grown essential oils like lavender, eucalyptus, and peppermint. The easy to use, individually wrapped wipes and quick-drying spray are great for speedy cleanses and tidying up little kids. —M.O.
