We can't wash our hands every five minutes, but it's easy to spritz a dollop of hand sanitizer. The World Health Organization, the CDC, and the Mayo Clinic all agree that hand sanitizer like this kills 99.9% of germs that cause infectious illnesses, even more effectively than soap and water.

Fraiss uses natural, non-toxic ingredients created by chemists in the United States from natural plants in Australia, keeps hands luxurious through the careful blend of natural essential oils, and has been approved by dermatologists as non-sensitizing and non-irritating. The history of the company is interesting—it was started by two gentlemen who were touring Cambodia and lamented why it was so difficult for keeping their hands sanitary.

Fraiss is now a worldwide business. The alcohol they produce from sugarcane takes less energy to produce than the corn alcohol used in generic hand sanitizer brands, which is good for the environment. Their products come in recycled packaging, and are never tested on animals.

A portion of all corporate proceeds goes to the Just a Drop Foundation, which supports water, sanitation, and health project all around the world, helping countries that lack basic necessities such as clean water.
